

(silent film & live music)


### Setting A:



**AUDIENCE** 

In case the musicians and/or their instruments interfere with the audience's visual field, the following setup is also possible (mirrored Setting-B is also possible).

#### Setting B:



NB: The ensemble's many years of experience confirms that a dislocation of the musicians in two different parts of the stage does not benefit and disrupts the music as well as the entire event.

#### Equipment provided by the band:

- · Lights: own note-stand lights
- · Instruments (if not otherwise discussed):
- trumpet or saxophone or guitar
- fender-rhodes electric piano
- double-bass & bass synth
- drums

#### Equipment provided by the organizer:

- · Lights: no stage lights needed.
- · 2x separate circuits 220V power plugs.
- · if explicitly requested by the band: freshly tuned piano (upright/grand)
- · Audio equipment:
- trumpet: jack-out from effect-board to DI
- or saxophone: suitable mic on stand - or guitar: suitable mic in front of gtr-amp
- piano: suitable mics (preferably 2: 1x low and 1xhigh)
- and/or keys: jack-out from effect board to DI
- double bass: xlr-out from own dpa4099 mic (no pick-up)
- synth: jack-out to DI
- drums: according to venue size either 1x bd-mic or 1x bd-mic + 2x over-head NB: no single mics on toms/snare/hi-hat
- · Screen format: 4:3, placed in the back of the stage area.
- · Projector/Beamer, with stand or roof holder if needed.
- · HDMI-cable to connect the band's PC set on stage to the projector/beamer.

NB: the film is provided by the band on a PC or USB 3.0 stick or as DCP.

#### Conditions:

- · Minimum 120 minutes for set-up and sound-check.
- · 4x warm meals, with beverages, before or after the concert.
- · Parking space for 1 vehicle as close as possible to the infrastructure where the concert takes place.
- · Eventual audio- and/or video recordings of the concert have to be discussed with the band before the sound-check.
